Actually, what I am doing is avoiding organizing my taxes! Hahaha! I should also be finishing the



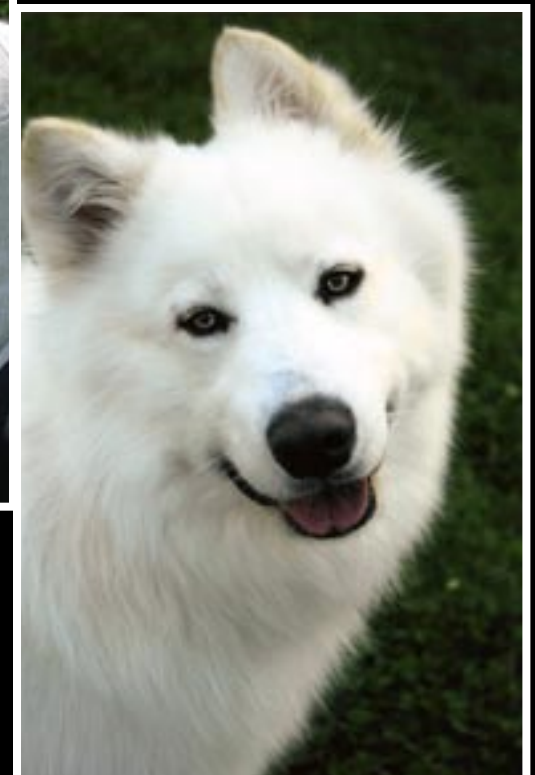
