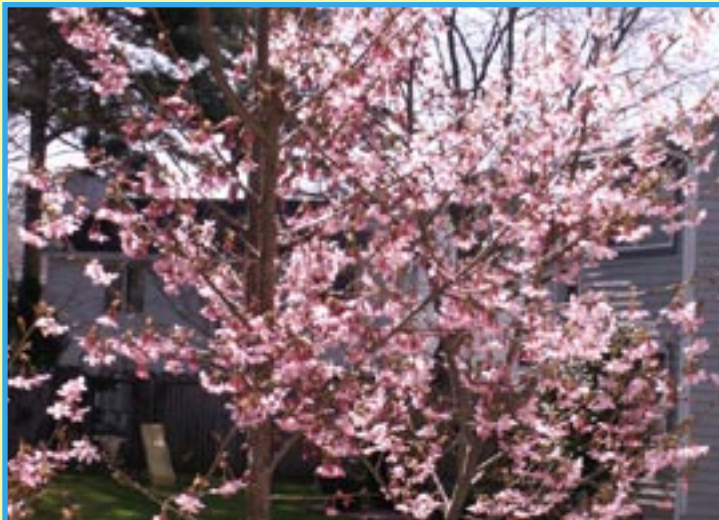

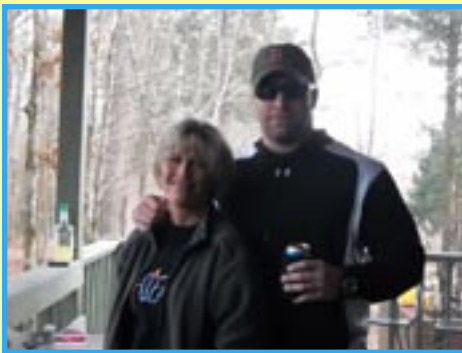

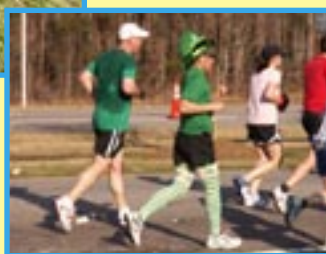
I told you, I think, last week that my youngest nephew is home on R&R in Mississippi right now. I have gotten lots of neat photos of him enjoying family this week.

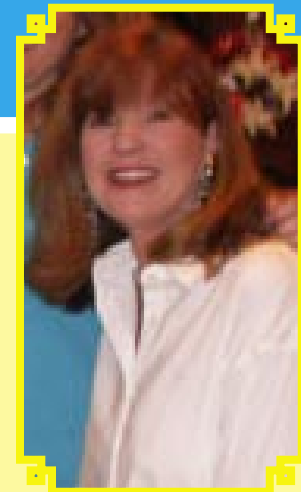
