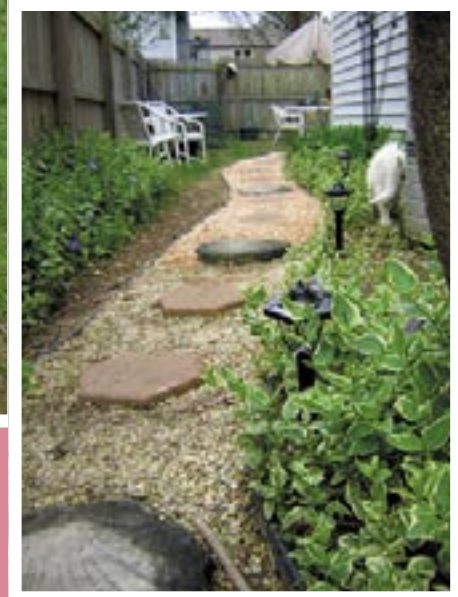
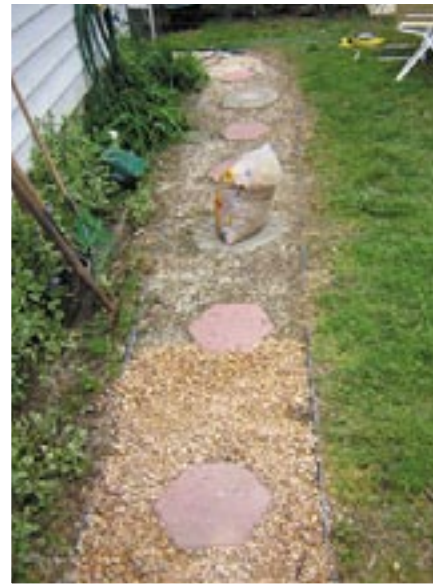
He was hilarious this weekend. Well, he was and he wasn't. I would plant something, turn around to do something else, and then when I swung back around, the plant would be GONE!

He ate two of my four yellow peppers and tried to eat the squash, too! Needless to say, that wasn't so funny...

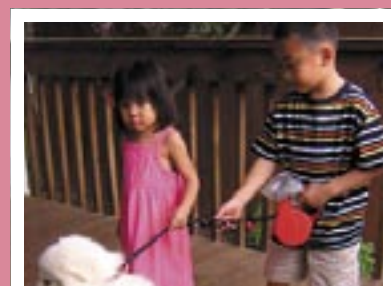
