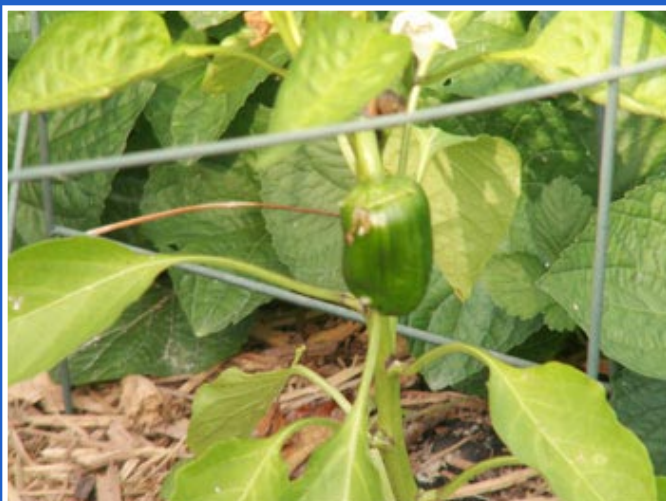


On the next page you see the fruits of my labor starting out! So young and tender! The FIGS are sprouting! That makes me so HAPPY!

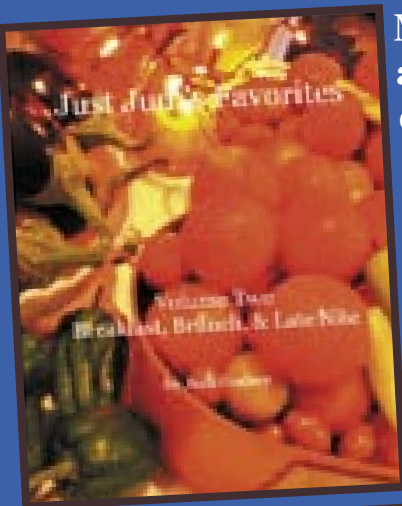
