Below you have Neal, Kim, and John, all very dear, long-time friends, and to the right are the ladies and gent who put this whole thing together.





I love this photo because Paul came up to me and asked how to buy a photograph that he liked. I found the photographer and "Boom!"

I just KNEW someone would say something about that. I should have known it would have been him. Sick, Chris, you are just sick! - (smile)


I really am not very energetic and do not have a lot to say tonight (for once) so I will end with my Pet Page and move on to my work which is sitting in my briefcase starring at me!
