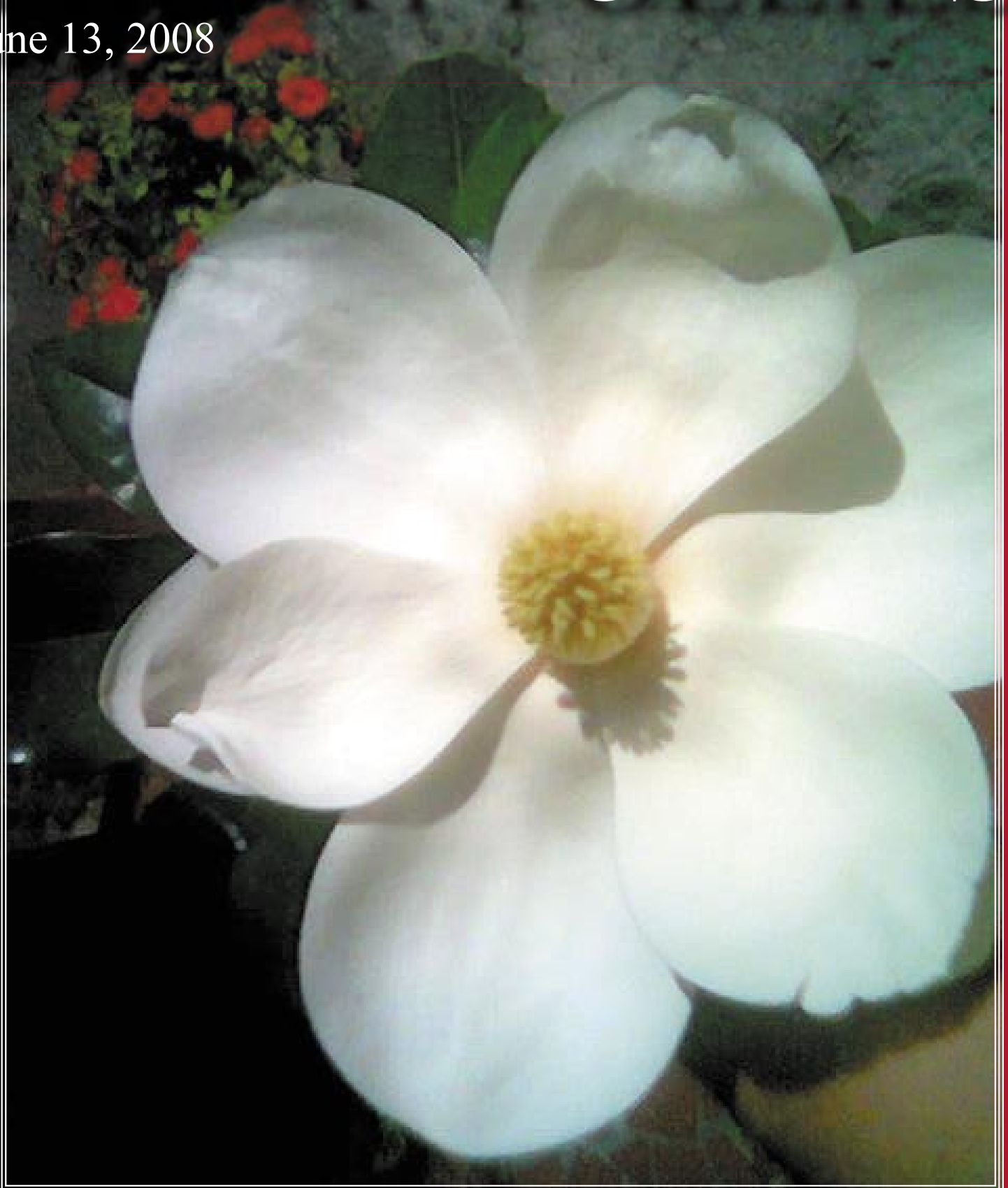

Have a GREAT one!

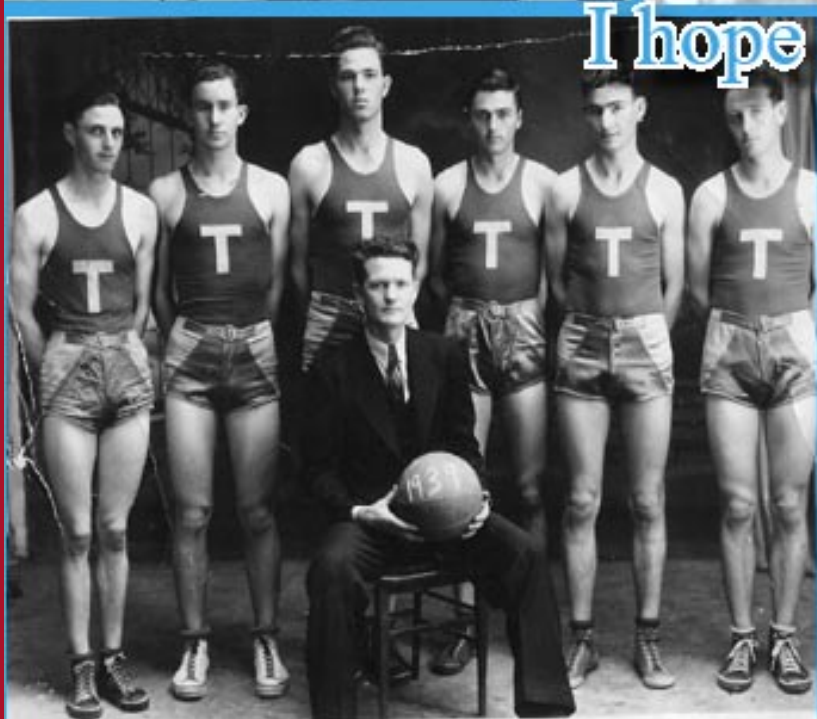
