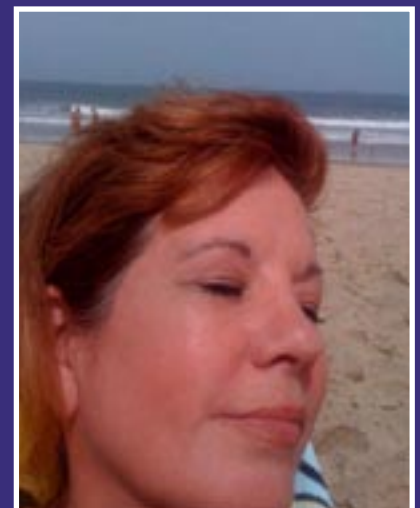
August 28, 2009

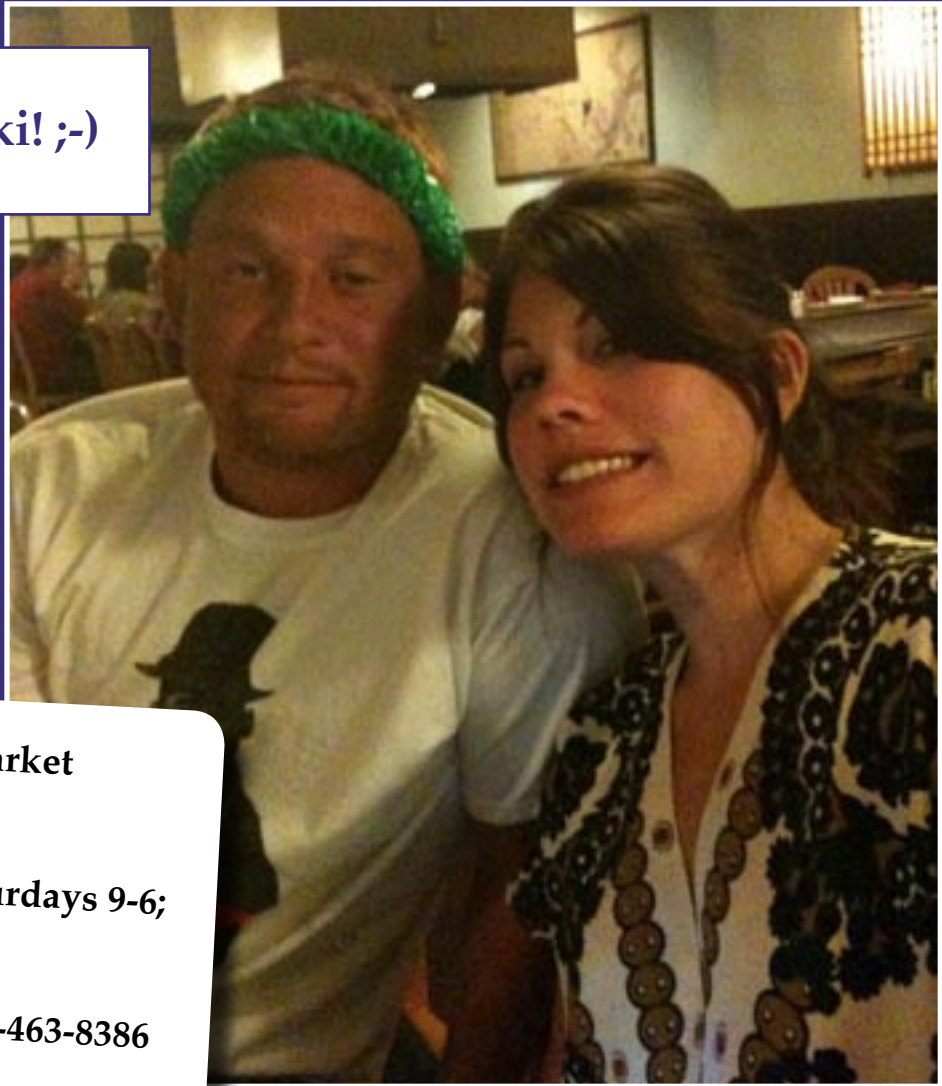

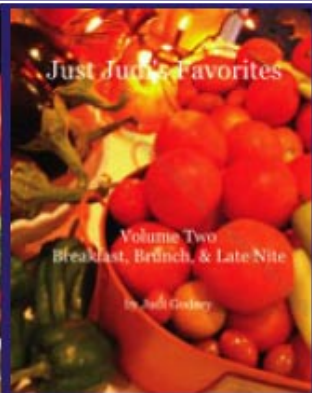
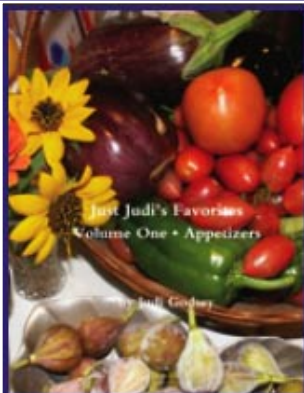
