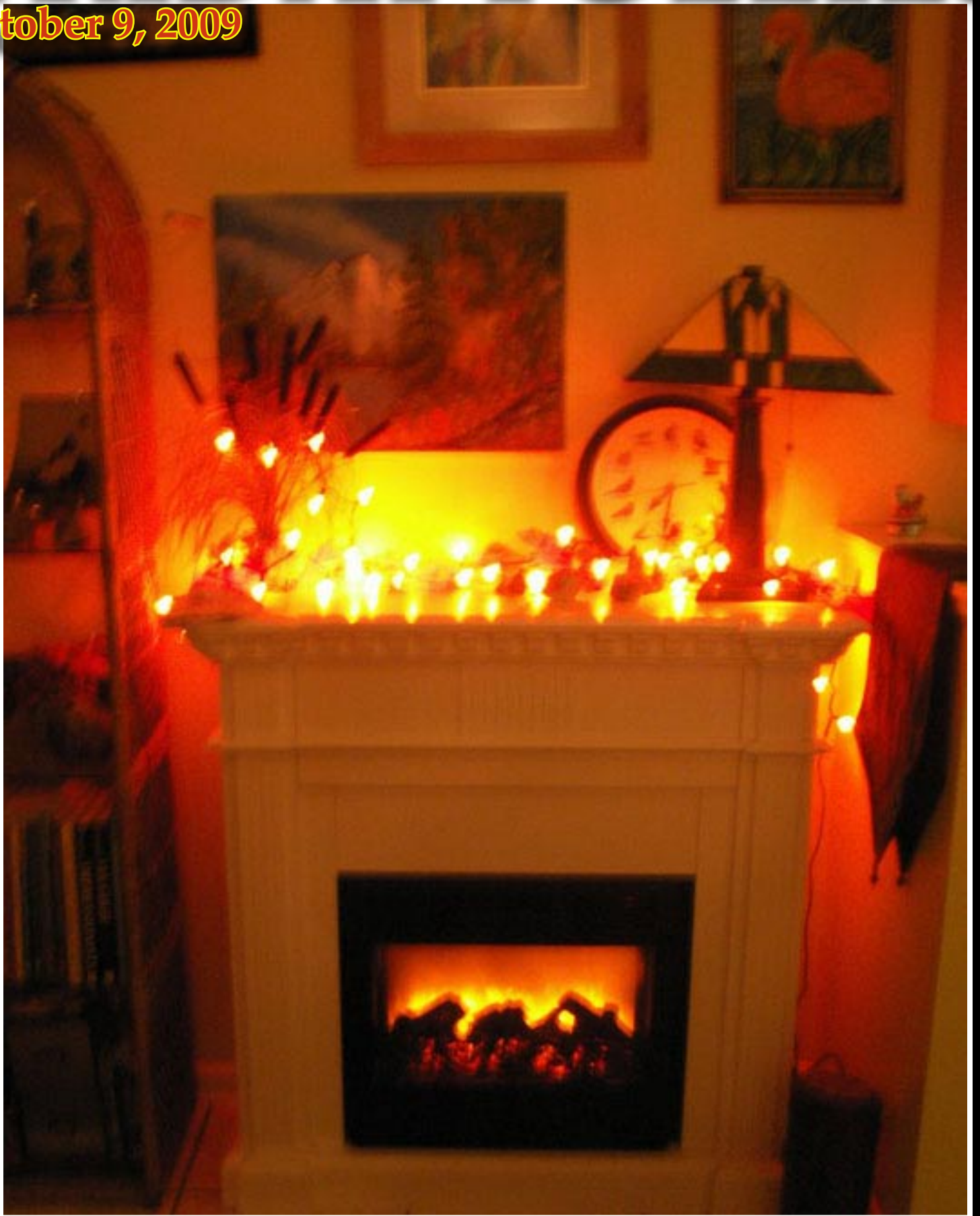


# FRIDAY FOLLIES
