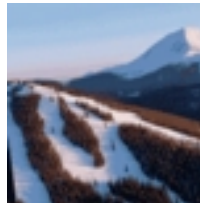
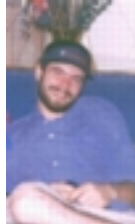

THE THIRD ANNIVERSARY

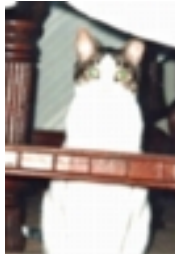
March 17, 2002

After 9/11, we adopted a cat who had belonged to a friend in Naval Intelligence. We call him "Bob, the Spy Cat."



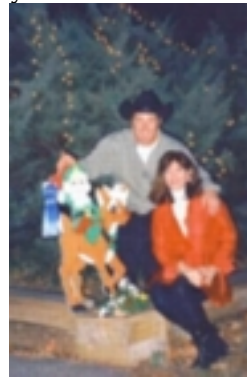
JP had his Radio Show, and I joined the Virginia Beach Rotary Club. We also founded the Richard Hassell Foundation.

We had our photo in the paper for St. Patty's Day,



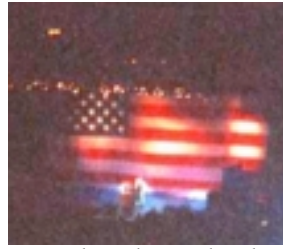
did some advertising for my hearing aid company,
